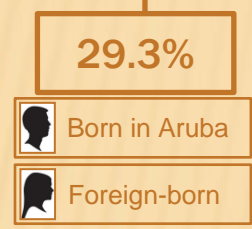

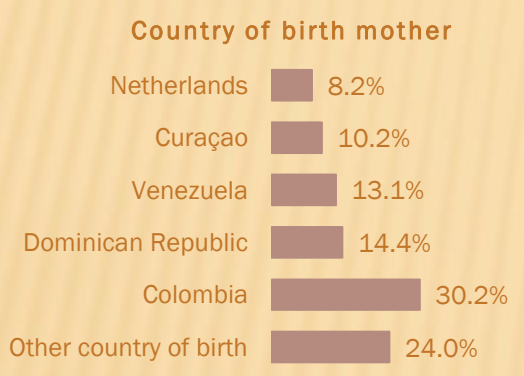

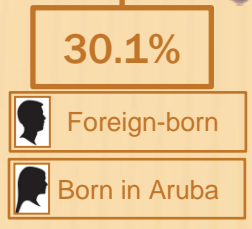
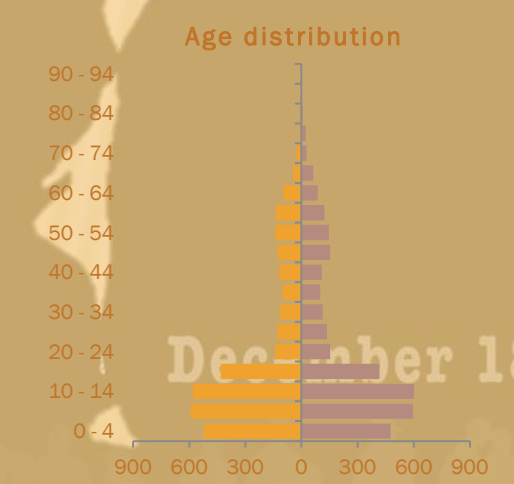
Second generation migrants born to a father born in Aruba and a foreign-born mother



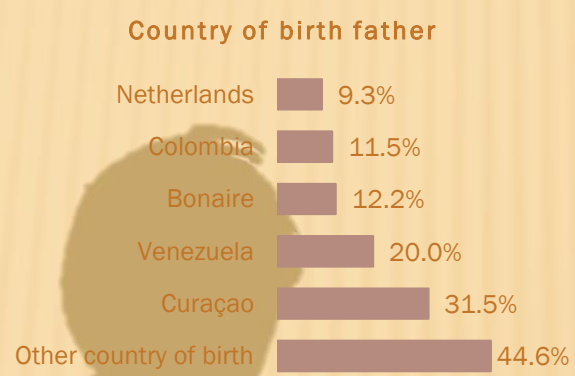
71.5% has secondary educational level or less

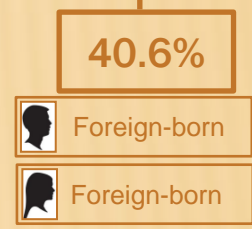
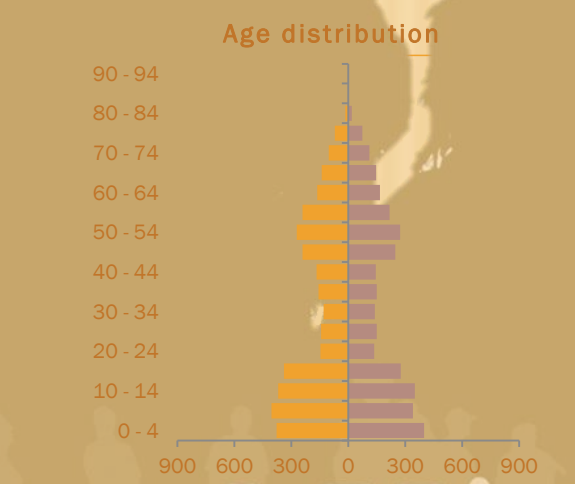
Second generation migrants born to a foreign-born father and a mother born in Aruba



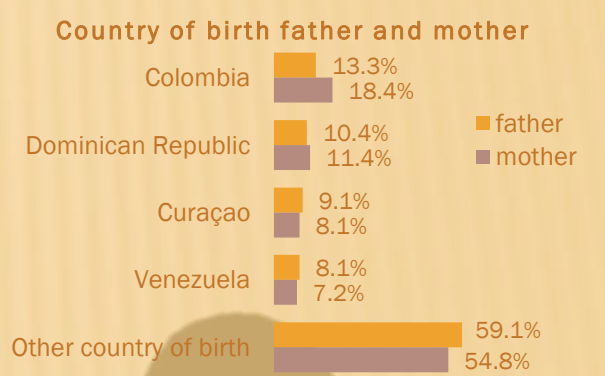
76.4% has secondary educational level or less
